The last few months have been very trying for everyone and for some have brought pain and loss. For those who have suffered, the Parish Councillors wish to express their condolences. We have also seen the most incredible community response, thank you to all our local volunteers. Stay well everyone.

### Community Governance Review

Wiltshire Council has now published its draft recommendations following the Parish Council's request to review what appeared to be the anomalous boundary at Sunnyhill Lane. The Parish Council also suggested that the parish should be united into one complete whole, rather than the current situation whereby it is divided into wards. To reflect the unity of the Parish, the Parish Council also suggested that Parish be formally renamed as Wilcot, Huish and Oare Parish Council.

Wiltshire Council is recommending that all these amendments are implemented. The Parish Council is pleased to report that Wiltshire Council recognised the anomaly on the map for what it was; all properties were already in Oare, despite the maps showing the boundary running through the Hillview Park! Wiltshire Council is recommending that the boundary line is clarified on the map, thus showing clearly that all properties are in Oare and thus avoiding confusion for future generations.
