Wilcot War Memorial

We have received notification of a major diversion scheduled for May, namely the A4 in Marlborough is to be closed to allow for resurfacing. The closures will be between the hours of 19:00 and 06:00 from the 7th to the 31 of May. A diversion will be in operation taking all traffic through Oare and Pewsey.
