Commensurate of which mortgage 24 Dec 1849. Part of Lot 9 Released 5 Oct 1824

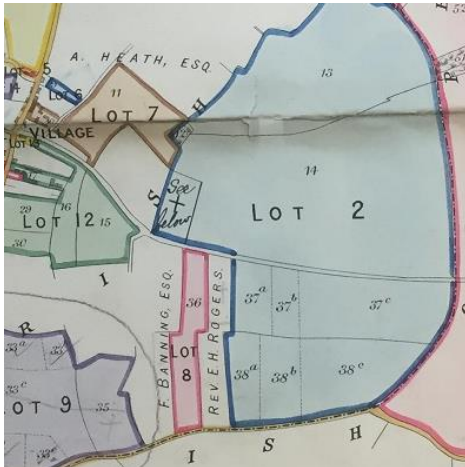
Lot 16 Oare House off Rudge lane shown on the Map.

12 Oct 1893 June Hitchcock of All Cannings and Ebenezer Lane of Woodborough.

24 Dec 1849 Between Rev Maurice Hillier Goodman and John Davis the younger and Timothy Goodman all lands and offices of M H Goodman and the Estate of Maurice Hillier 303 Acres were conveyed by MH Goodman into the use of J Davis and T Goodman and their heirs forever by way of mortgage for recovering payment to them the sum of £5,000 for part of Lot 2
